The mobile ecosystem is never idle and surprising consumers with new and innovative offerings. The smartphone brands are showcasing exciting technology and coming out with new products with the “wow” factor.

2019 is already spiced up with promising new technologies, and we are going to explore the top ones in this post. Foldable Phones

Many brands have been toying with the idea of foldable phones, but Samsung and Huawei are the ones leading the pack. Samsung unveiled the Galaxy Fold which can be folded like a book and opens to offer a 7.3-inch tablet-sized display.

Huawei's Mate X offers an 8-inch display and can folds on the outside, unlike Samsung. Both the models are going to hit the market in a few months and can put you back by around \$2,000.

The foldable phones offer two separate displays which become one when you fold the phone to offer a bigger screen. Both the phones come with 512GB internal storage and run on Android 9.0 Pie.

Powerful Cameras with Multiple Lenses

You may think that the race for achieving high megapixels is over. But the trend is quite the opposite with Xiaomi planning to introduce a 48-megapixel camera phone in 2019. Currently, Nokia Lumia 1020 offers a 41-megapixel camera while Huawei uses a 40-megapixel lens in their Mate 20 Pro and P20 Pro.

We can expect the race to heat up with more brands coming out with powerful cameras in 2019. Nokia is also releasing the 9 PureView with five lenses for high-quality photography, and LG has also followed suit with the V40 ThinQ. LG is going to take things a step further by applying for a patent for 16-lens smartphone design.

Blazing Fast 5G Phones

3G and LTE can be things of the past with brands like Apple, Google, Honor, Nokia, Huawei,

Samsung and others working on 5G phones.

5G is still at its nascent stage, and carriers haven't started offering the service as yet. Carriers like Verizon, AT&T, [T-Mobile](#) and [Sprint](#) plan to offer 5G service in selected cities in 2019 which can attain top speeds of 20 Gbps.

5G is able to boost the speeds of even LTE networks and can become a common trend as Snapdragon 855 chip is using a new powerful modem which will drive many smartphones in coming years.

High-Storage microSD Cards

Some of us are never satisfied with the storage options available today. Sure, we have microSD cards, but how about one that can support 1TB?

Sandisk and Micron have come out with 1TB microSD cards for recording all your videos in 4K and installing an endless number of games and apps. But before you rush to buy a 1TB card, the phones will have to provide support for them in the first place.
