We will see how well they can adapt with so much plastic in their environment. Some may find opportunity while others suffer.

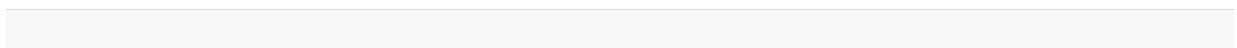


Who knew that so much plastic in the oceans would lead to this career for Dr. Sawfish: the Conjoined Seal Surgeon?
